



**MASTERS LEVEL DIRECTED STUDIES COURSE REM 664-5 or 665-5**

A Directed Studies course may not focus specifically on a student’s final research project. The student will need to complete a significant, tangible outcome, such as an annotated bibliography or substantial research paper. Students should discuss the proposed study with the supervising faculty member at least one month before the registration period in which they plan to enroll in 664 or 665. Directed Studies courses are marked using normal grading standards for REM courses.

Before registering in a directed studies course, the student must:

- Prepare and submit a course outline describing the work to be completed and the deadlines to the supervising faculty member.
- Attach the approved course outline to this form and submit to the REM Graduate Administrator for review and approval by the Chair of Graduate Studies.
